




Jonah Learns a Lesson











- 1. Fold the sheet in half along the solid line so that the pictures face out. Look at diagram 1. Cut through the dashed line to make an opening.
- 2 Open the sheet and spread it out. Then, fold it in half so that boxes 2, 3, 4 and 5 are on the same side, as shown in diagram 2.
- **3.** Fold the two ends of the booklet to the solid line. See diagram 3.
- 4. Unfold the ends of the book. Now fold the sheet in half and, taking the ends, push them towards the center until the pages come together. Look at diagrams 4 and 5.
- **5.**Fold pages 1 and 8 around the rest of the pages, so that they are like the booklet covers.
- **6.** Use this booklet to review the Bible story. Read the message on page 8 and remember the important lesson that Jonah learned.

Note to the teacher: If necessary, make copies of these instructions for all teachers and assistants, so they can read them while helping the children put together their booklet.
