
- 1. Make sure Student Activity Sheets 227a and 227b are printed front and back.
- 2. Cut along the dotted lines to create a door hanger, a bookmark, a mini poster, and a magnet.
- 3. Color and decorate the door hanger. When you finish, cover it with transparent contact paper.
- 4. Cover the bookmark with transparent contact paper or wide transparent adhesive tape and punch out the circle at the top. Put a ribbon or yarn through the hole. Your teacher can help you.
- 4. Cover the mini poster with transparent contact paper. Glue it onto a piece of colored paper or make a frame for it.
- 5. When you're done with steps 1-4, stick a magnet on the back side of the 10 Commandments graphic. Put this on your fridge to help you remember to put God first.
