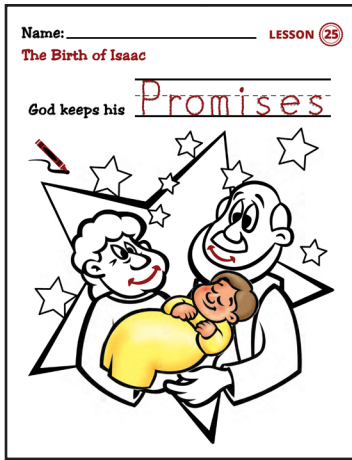
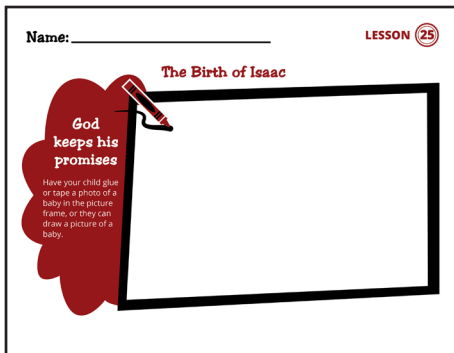


The Birth of Issac



Today we celebrated the fulfillment of the promise that God made to Abraham: the birth of his son Isaac.

Instructions: Cut out the figure of baby Isaac and make glue available for the children to attach the figures. Have the children point to Abraham and Sarah and tell them: "Isaac is the son of Abraham and Sarah. When Isaac was born, Sarah said that God brought her laughter. The name Isaac means laugh or laughter. Can you guess what is missing in the drawing?" (The smile on the face of Sarah and Abraham). Let the children color the picture and draw smiles on the faces of the people. Then let them attach the figure of baby Isaac in Sarah's arms. Remind them that God has the power to keep His promises (Romans 4:21).



Have your child glue or tape a photo of a baby in the picture frame, or they can draw a picture of a baby.
