*“Don’t let anyone look down on you because you are young, but set an example for the believers in speech, in conduct, in love, in faith and in purity.”*

Let your life, just as your words, be an example to others. Love like Jesus commands us to love, and be careful not to sin. Let your faith in Christ be known to all.

Don’t neglect the gift that is in you, which was given to you by God. Timothy, you have been given gifts to build up the church.
