



Jesus, the Son of God, could do everything without limitations. He helped others and healed a girl who was very sick (Luke 8:40-42, 49-56). Talk with your child about Jesus, our friend. He takes care of us when we are sick; We can tell him how we feel. Encourage your child to tell you the Bible story, using the picture cards and putting them in the right order.



Instructions: Have your students to cut out the four boxes. You may need to help them with this activity. Then have student mix up their cards, so that they are disordered. Explain that they should put their cards in the correct order according to what they learned in the Bible story today.

Check that they have done well; If not, clarify any questions that may arise and emphasize that Jesus takes care of people. In this case he took care of the sick girl and her family. Jesus healed her because he is the Son of God and only he does what no one else can do. Say: Jesus also takes care of you and will always be with you. Ask your students the following questions and let them respond:



- How does Jesus care for you?
- How does Jesus show his love for others?
- How do your parents show you their love?
