



Today's story is found in Exodus 14:1-31. God helped the Israelites cross the Red Sea. Your child learned that Moses trusted in God, and that we also should trust in Him. Help your child remember the verse that says, "The Lord is good... He takes good care of those who trust in him" (Nahum 1:7). Pray together, giving thanks to God for His care and love.



Instructions: Cut out the figures of Moses, the Israelites, the Egyptian army, and the bases. Each base slides into the slits on the figures. Then fold the bottom of the page so the sea picture on this page can be seen in front of the other picture of the mountains and the sea. Then place the

picture of the Israelites between the two water sections to represent the passage of the Israelites through the Red Sea. Later, you can take the Israelites out from the two parts of water and replace them with the Egyptian army and cover the army with the water. Let the children tell what they learned in the biblical story using the figures.
