sinned against God. Standing where they were, they read the book of the Law of God, their God, a quarter of the day, and for another quarter of the day they confessed their sins and worshiped the Lord their God. The people were sorry for having disobeyed God for so many years. They wanted to change. So together, they made a promise to fulfill the laws that God had given Moses. They promised to obey all the commands that God had given them. This time they were determined to obey God.

(This Bible story is found in Nehemiah 8:1–9:3; 9:38; 10:29-39.)

To give up something for awhile, often food, so you can dedicate yourself to thinking about God and what he wants you to do. Time set aside for prayer and worshipping God.
