
Jesus Visits Zacchaeus





This is the last lesson that tells us about how Jesus grew. This week we talked about Zacchaeus (Luke 19:1-9). Ask your child to use the activity that they did in the class to tell you what happened when Zacchaeus met Jesus.





Instructions:

Cut out the figures of Zacchaeus. Put tape on the back of the figures to stick them on and take them off easily. Ask the children to move the figures of Zacchaeus and place them in the correct place as they tell what they learned in today's class.

Ask them:

- Why did Zacchaeus climb the tree?
- What did Jesus do when he saw him?
- What did Zacchaeus do after meeting Jesus?

Tell them:

Zacchaeus learned that God loved him. God also loves us!



My Photo Book About Jesus



Cut out the figures. Then have the child paste them onto the corresponding Photo Book about Jesus. Have them fold the page in the form of an accordion, with the page divided into four sections.
