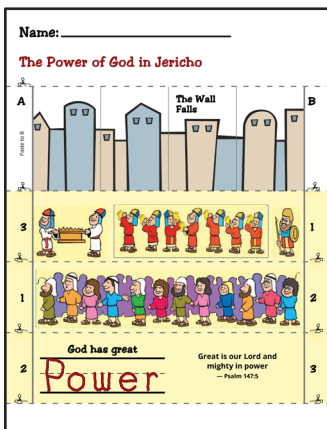


Dear
Parents:

This week we talked about Joshua (Joshua 6:1-25). The faith of Joshua resulted in a complete victory for the Israelites. The Canaanites thought Jericho was invincible. God showed his power and his faithfulness, and affirmed that he is the only true God, and that he is always ready and willing to help his people. Emphasize that we can trust the power of God when we are afraid. Encourage the children to seek God's blessings during the week and help each day.

Instructions: Have the child trace the Word of Faith (Power). Then help them cut out the figure below and have them paste it onto the designated spot on the activity sheet. On the activity sheet, help them carefully cut with round-tipped scissors, the outline of the biblical scene. Instruct them to follow the dashed lines and the four strips of illustrations. Show them how to attach strips to each other, using adhesive tape or glue, following numbering, to form a circle.



Help them to fold the strip of the walls along the solid lines and join them to the back where they are indicated. This will leave a square representing the city.
