Peter Helps a Lame Man

Peter was a disciple of Jesus

"They never stopped teaching and proclaiming the good news that Jesus is the Messiah." — Acts 5:42

Instructions: Tell them to trace the Faith Word (Jesus). Let the child follow the path from Peter and John to the lame man (there are three possible paths). When they have finished doing this, repeat the memory verse (Acts 5:42). Then help them to cut out the figure of the formerly lame man now jumping for joy (below). Help them attach it over the previous figure.

Say: "Peter spoke to the lame man about the power of Jesus! God healed him and he was able to walk and jump. Thank God for his love and Son, Jesus."
