
## Peter Tells the Good News to Cornelius






Today your child learned that Jesus' love is for everyone. Ask your child to tell you the Bible Story we studied today: "Peter visits a captain of 100 soldiers named Cornelius" (Acts 10:1-2, 17-24, 28, 34-36).



**Instructions:** Allow your child to connect the dots by following the numbers to trace the figure of Cornelius' house. Have them trace the Word of Faith (Jesus). Help the child carefully cut out the figures of Peter and Cornelius found below. Ask them to stick them at the entrance of the house. As they do this activity review what they have learned during the Bible story, and repeat the memory verse at the bottom of the activity sheet.



Have them trace the Word of Faith (Jesus) and color in the statement. As your child works, remind them that Peter was a follower of Jesus. Many people heard the good news of salvation thanks to him. We can also tell people what God did for us.
