


The Parable of the Good Samaritan



Today we learned about the Good Samaritan. He was a man who was kind to a Jewish traveler who was injured (Luke 10:25-37). We learned that we can be kind to other people. Pay attention to how your child relates to others and encourage them to be kind to their peers.



Instructions:

1. After your student writes their name above and traces the key words on the front of their worksheet, ask them to color the clothes of the man who is injured.

2. Help your students cut along the dotted lines so that they have three sections. Then help them cut along the dotted vertical lines in the first section. Only cut along the dotted lines.

3. Use adhesive tape and tape together sections 2 and 3 where the letters A and B are indicated so that you have a strip of drawings. Help your students place the beginning of the strip through the openings on the first section. If you have time, allow your students to review the Bible story using their worksheets. Encourage them to try to be as kind to others as the Good Samaritan was to the Jewish man.
