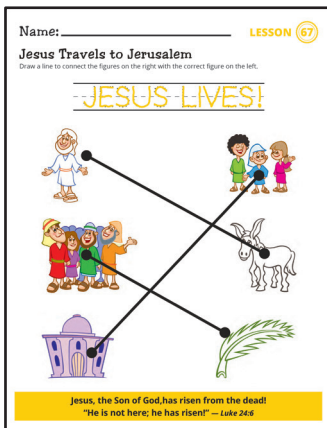


Jesus Travels to Jerusalem

Today we learned about the triumphal entry of Jesus into Jerusalem (Matthew 21:11, 15-16). Explain to your children that the words “Hosanna” and “Hallelujah” are expressions that were used in Bible times to give thanks and praise to God. Emphasize the importance of praising God and always being thankful.



Instructions:

Give your children Student Activity Sheet 67b. Tell them to write their name and trace this unit’s words of faith: “Jesus lives!” Then, ask them to join the figures that are related while you do a brief review of the story. Tell them that Holy Week is a special time, when we read that Jesus, the Son of God, came into the world to die for us and rose again to give us victory. Remember how the children of our Bible story praised God? (Shouting “Hosanna!”)

Attendance Sheets:

Allow time for your children to find their attendance sheet while helping any new children to begin theirs. Cut out and hand out the attendance stamp (heart) below and ask the children to stick them in the appropriate place, while saying something they learned in the Bible story.
