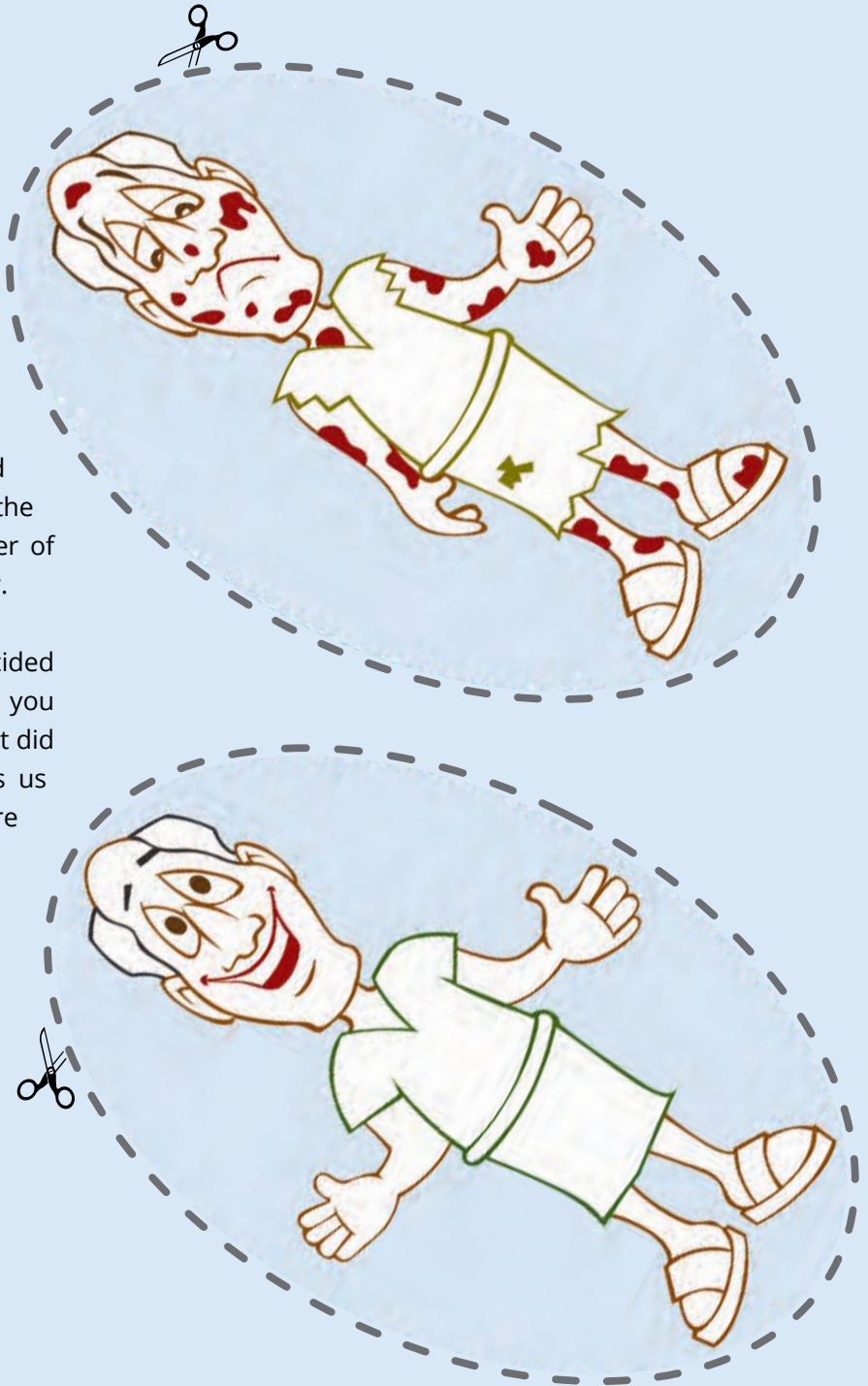
# Naaman Obeys and Trusts God

## INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Give each student a worksheet and two ice cream sticks. Allow time for the children to color and cut out the two pictures on the worksheet. Then help them glue an ice cream stick to each of the pictures like the example.

2. Provide a sheet of blue construction paper or heavy paper to each child. Make a vertical cut in the bottom of the blue paper and insert the figure. Now the children can move the pictures up and down, simulating the number of times that Naaman washed in the Jordan River.

3. Say: "Naaman was very sick and when he decided to trust God and obey him, he got better. Can you tell me about a time when you were sick? What did you do to feel better? Sometimes God gives us doctors and medicine to help us when we are sick. God uses doctors and medicine to help us feel better. Remember that God is always with us and we can talk to him when we feel sick."
