Job Trusts God Despite His Problems

**TRUST**  
is believing that God will do what He promised He will do.

Job loved God. Many bad things happened to Job.

Job's friends talked and talked but none of them could help him.

## Instructions:

1. Give each student a worksheet. Ask them to trace the word "Trust" and write their names on their papers. Then, following the dotted lines, have them cut out the three circles, the square with the word "trust" on it, and the strip with their name.
2. Briefly review the Bible story as the children glue the shapes onto a colored piece of construction paper. (See the example).
3. Ask your students: "What happened to Job?" (Allow the children to respond.) "What did Job do when so many bad things happened?" (He trusted God.)
4. Let your students take home their work and encourage them to tell others what they learned from the Bible story.
