

Dear Parents:

Isaac Decides to Be Kind



During today's lesson we studied that Isaac was kind to people, even when they were not kind to him (Genesis 23:17-31). Ask your child to tell your family what they learned during the Bible story. Talk with them about what it means to make good decisions and be kind to others.

Instructions:

1. Ask your students to cut the worksheet in half along the thick solid black line. Then have them fold in half the section with the animals on it. This will be the background.
2. Allow time for your students to color the figures and cut them out. When they're done, glue a flat wooden stick (ice cream stick) on the back of each group of figures (see example).
3. Encourage your students to use these figures to remember the Bible story and tell it to their family and friends.
